Environmental Stewardship Projects

Wednesday Oct 11th at Tower Grove Park. Bird garden planting.

We are partnering with Tower Grove Park to continue their restoration of the Gaddy Bird Garden at the northwest corner of the Park. Meet at the entrance to the Gaddy. We are planting perennial flowers; bring a shovel or trowel if you have one. RAIN DATE OCT 13TH.

Saturday Oct 21st at Creve Coeur Park. Planting project.

We will be planting the Mallard Lake shoreline with a variety of native shrubs and small trees. Bring a shovel if you have one, and waterproof boots or waders might be helpful. We will meet in the south lot at the Creve Coeur Lakehouse, 2160 Creve Coeur Mill Road, St. Louis, MO 63146.

Saturday Nov 11th at Creve Coeur Park. Honeysuckle removal.

Bring your favorite lopper or saw. Meet at the Katy Trail Connector parking lot at the Eileen Pfeiffer Shelter on River Valley Drive, just west of the overpass to Hwy 364. RAIN DATE NOV 18TH.

Saturday, Dec 9th at Creve Coeur Park. Bradford Pear Purge.

Help us remove this pest plant. We will meet at the “red sheds” visible just west of Hwy 141, but accessed thru the park entrance at 150 River Valley Dr, Chesterfield, MO 63017. Go thru the entrance, turn left and follow the signs. Power tools will be in use; adults only.
